HAMILTON

1776, New York City

Our mini show opens with Alexander Hamilton, an ambitious immigrant who arrives in New York during the American Revolution. His intelligence and determination quickly earn the attention of revolutionary leaders like George Washington.

Eliza Schuyler marries Hamilton, while her sisters Angelica and Peggy share a women's perspective on the Revolution in ***"The Schuyler Sisters,"*** expressing their desire to be part of something greater.

Across the ocean, King George III delivers his satirical love ballad ***"You'll Be Back,"*** humorously warning the colonies that rebellion will be met with force.

As the Revolution ends, the focus shifts to the challenges of building a new nation. In ***"Non-Stop,"*** Hamilton's relentless ambition shines as he writes *The Federalist Papers* and becomes the nation's first Secretary of the Treasury, while Aaron Burr grows envious of Hamilton's success.

In ***"What'd I Miss,"*** Thomas Jefferson returns from France, full of swagger and curiosity about the new government that formed in his absence. He heads to New York to join Washington's cabinet, setting the stage for his rivalry with Hamilton.

Finally, in ***"The Room Where It Happens,"*** Burr's frustration reaches a peak as Hamilton makes a secret deal with Jefferson and James Madison—trading political support for placing the nation's capital in what becomes Washington, D.C.

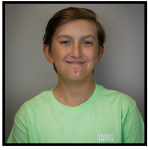

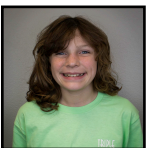

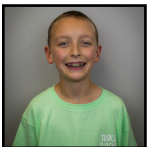
